Award Categories

FUNdamentals Coach of the Year

This award recognizes the outstanding contribution of a coach of children in the development of basic skills, within the FUNdamental and learning to play and practice phases of development.

Health & lifelong participation Coach of the Year

This award recognises the outstanding contribution of the coach to get more people starting, staying and/or succeeding in aquatics through high-quality coaching.

Skill-Development Coach of the Year

This award recognises the achievements of a coach working to develop emerging and young performers from within swimming.

High-Performance Coach of the Year

This award recognises the achievements of a coach working with athletes at the highest level of performance in their sport.

Young Coach of the Year

This award recognises the important work carried out by up-and-coming coaches through recognition of their coaching achievements so far. This award recognises nominees aged 25 years or under.

The Coaching Chain: The Appreciation of Coaching Award

This award recognises the contributions made by a group of coaches throughout an athlete's development in helping them achieve their potential. This is a chance for athletes or employers to recognise the range of coaches involved in developing an athlete from their first involvement in sport, to the recognition of potential and nurturing of talent to those working with them at their highest level.

This award recognises and celebrates the importance of progressive athlete-centred coaching and the continuous, dedicated support and time which is invested in athletes throughout their career from numerous coaches and support personnel to enable them to reach their potential.

Lifetime Achievement Award

This award will be presented in exceptional circumstances to recognise the achievements of an individual through a lifetime dedicated to coaching, sport and/or the development of athletes.

Coach Educator of the Year

This award is for an individual who has made a significant contribution to the development of coaching and individual coaches in the region through delivery of effective education & development programmes.

Coaching Environment of the Year

This award seeks to recognise an organisation that has created a quality environment for the support and development of coaches, showing innovation and the potential for knowledge transfer through an effective system or environment. Examples could include a Swim 21 club, swim school, local authority, private leisure provider, county sport partnership, School sports partnership.
